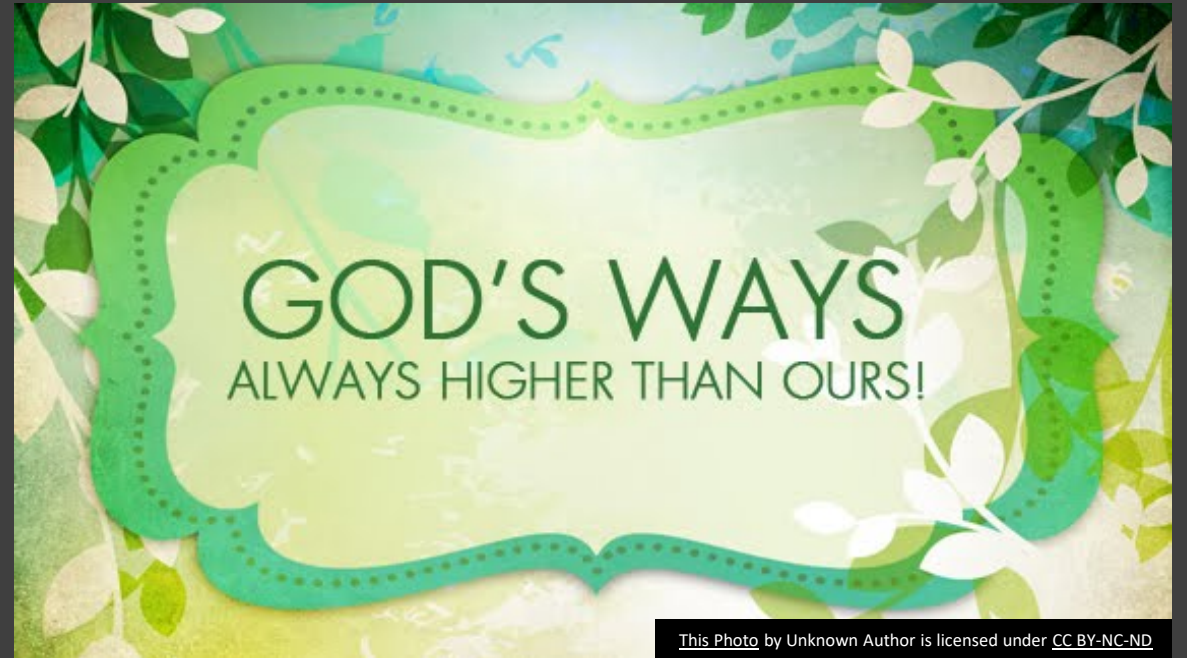
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Read Job 4 -8



# The first dialogue with Job

- Job friends unaware of conversation between Satan and God offer:
- Accusations
- Arguments
- Justification
- Their Wisdom



# Eliphaz's Perspective

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## Job chapter 4 Innocent Do not Suffer

[Job 4:1-6.](#)

Reprimands Job – accusation Job not religious enough

[Job 4:7-11.](#)

God's judgment is reserved to the wicked  
The righteous do not suffer

[Job 4:12-21.](#)

Shares a vision – to prove his point  
All creatures are subject to God - even angels

Perspective

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Job 5:1-5. Danger for those who live foolishly

Job 5:6-7. Seek - look for God

Job 5:8-16. God takes care of the poor  
God knows/sees what deceitful  
people do

Job 5:17-  
27. Insists he is right "This we have searched out; it is  
true. Hear it and know for yourself."

[Job 6:1-7.](#) His grief brought on by God's arrows  
He no longer desires food

[Job 6:8-13](#) He wishes for death, wherein  
[Job 7:1-11.](#) he is assured of comfort.

[Job 6:14-30](#) He tells his friends they should  
[Job 7:11-21.](#) be more understanding and kind  
Tells friends to prove he sinned  
Wonders why God is bothering him

<sup>14</sup> “Anyone who withholds kindness from a friend forsakes the fear of the Almighty.

<sup>15</sup> But my brothers are as undependable as intermittent streams, as the streams that overflow

<sup>16</sup> when darkened by thawing ice and swollen with melting snow,

<sup>17</sup> but that stop flowing in the dry season, and in the heat vanish from their channels.
